9. Reports from the following with discussion:

- a. Federal or State Congressional Delegates or Representatives
-None Present.
- b. Tribal Projects / Programs
-Jim McCormick with the Pawnee Nation thanked everyone for coming and welcomed them to the Pawnee Nation.
-Rob Endicott with the Cherokee Nation reported that he was notified that Mayes County Br 15 had been approved for \$1 million in tribal funding.
- c. INCOG
-Viplav Putta with INCOG briefed everyone on how the recent MAP 21 legislation would affect INCOG. He mentioned that INCOG partnered with the Muskogee VA and received a \$500,000 grant to help transport veterans to doctors meetings, appointments, etc.
- d. ODOT
Nothing to Report.
- e. ACCO / OCCEDB
-Randy Robinson with OCCEDB reminded everyone of the ACCO Auction in McAlester on September 22nd.
-Mr. Robinson also reported that the State Wide CED Board recently adopted the 2012 County Road and Design Guidelines Manual and it will now go to the State Transportation Committee for final approval. Once approved, the manual will be available on the ACCO website.
-The ODOT GIS Committee met earlier this week and decided to form a sub-committee to create a Data Dictionary that could be used state-wide.
-After the Attorney General's ruling that it was legal to require Utility Permits, it was clarified that a county cannot make a profit off those permits. Permits fees shall only cover any costs to the County.
-Everyone was reminded that it is important to leave the shear connectors on the I-40 crosstown beams for added strength and longevity of the bridge being constructed.
-The ACCO Legislative Committee will be sending out requests for items that Commissioners would like considered in the next legislative year. The committee will then review the requests and prioritize the items to send forward.
-Mr. Robinson reported that he has received many questions about the ability of Commissioners to load post roads. To clarify, Commissioners are allowed to load post roads that will apply to everyone but Agriculture vehicles. This is possible under the Attorney General opinion #41 from 2001. Once a road has been posted Troop S of the Highway Patrol must be notified. There is a link on the OCCEDB website (OCCEDB.org) to commonly asked questions and answers including state statutes.
- f. SIG / SIF Program
-Jim Clark reported that premiums are bringing in good interest returns. He also asked that Counties keep track of their equipment spread out through the county and if it is in danger of a natural disaster the equipment be moved to a safe location. Finally, once a County receives notice of a lawsuit the County should send the information to ACCO and let the SIG/SIF lawyers

deal with the litigation, not the local DA's office. If a lawsuit is started by the DA's office ACCO cannot take over the lawsuit at a later time.

- g. County Advisory Board (CAB)
-Nothing to report.

-No change to the plan. Ottawa County's ETR Extension was approved at the OCCEDB meeting on 8/29/2012.
 - b. Bridge Replacement (BR) (Attachment 10b)
-James Pruett mentioned that Creek County will probably swap their 2013 Dog Creek project for their 2014 Scholar Creek project.
-Everyone was reminded that the counties lose control of their money on December 31st.
 - c. Surface Transportation Program (STP) (Attachment 10c)
-No change to the list. The new applications should be out soon, so counties should think about possible projects now.
 - d. Material Request Program (MRP) (Attachment 10d)
-No change to the list. There are currently no requests.
 - e. County Improvements to Roads & Bridges (CIRB) (Attachment 10e)
 - i) Keetonville Road 86th Street Connection revised project
A revised Keetonville Road project was presented with an engineer's estimate of \$6.1 million. This would create a \$900,000 deficit in the CIRB Plan in FY 2015. -Matt Casillas and Bruce Martin from ODOT Division 8 gave a presentation on Closed and Temporary Bridges. That presentation is available on the CED #1 website at www.CED1.org. Mr. Martin discussed how pipe dimensioning works in temporary structures and what constitutes a closed and temporary bridge structure. He also discussed what constitutes a Structurally Deficient and Functionally Obsolete bridge and options for replacement.
12. Discussion of 2013 CED#1 Board Officer Elections. (Attachment 12)
-Mr. Deckard reminded the board that nominations for Board Officers must be turned into the Secretary, Scott Hilton, by September 15th. Only current board members are eligible for election, so if someone would like to be an officer that is not currently on the board their County needs to pass a resolution making them their County board member before the September 15th deadline.

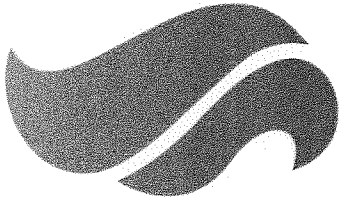

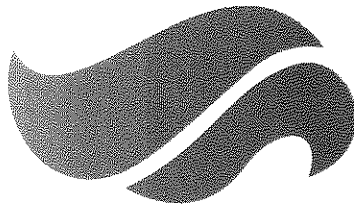

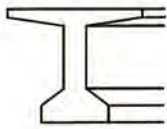

- Section 6. Absence: Any member of the Board of Directors who shall have been absent from two (2) consecutive regular meetings of the Circuit Engineering District during a single administrative year shall automatically vacate the seat on the Board of Directors and the vacancy shall be filled as provided for in Title 69, § 687.1 O.S., however, the Board of Directors shall consider each absence of an elected officer or Director as a separate circumstance and may expressly waive such absence by affirmative vote of a majority of Board Members.
- Section 7. Vacancies and Removal: Any vacancy occurring on the Board of Directors between terms of office shall be filled by as provided for in Title 69, § 687.1 O.S. with said person to serve out the remainder of the term.
- Section 8. Compensation: Directors shall not receive any compensation for their services.

Article VIII

Selection of Officers and Terms of Office

- Section 1. Elected officers: The elected officers of this Circuit Engineering District shall be a President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer to be elected by the Circuit Engineering District Regular Membership during any regular or special meeting after October 1st and before the end of each calendar year and to serve until their successors have been duly elected and assume office.
- Section 2. Qualifications for Office: Any member of the Board of Directors from a member county in good standing, who submits to the Board Secretary in writing their name and office for which they wish to be elected by September 15th of each year shall be placed on the ballot.

At the Regular Meetings of the Circuit Engineering District and at such other times as he shall deem proper, the President shall communicate to the members such matters and make such suggestions, as may in his/her opinion, tend to promote the welfare and increase the usefulness of the Circuit Engineering District.
