10. Reports from the following with discussion:

- a. Congressional Representatives

-None present.

- b. Tribal Representatives

-Rob Endicott with the Cherokee Nation briefed the group that a new Transportation Funding Bill, aka FAST ACT, was recently passed. FAST ACT gives increased funding to the tribes. They will receive from \$465 million in 2016 up to \$505 million in 2020. The FAST ACT also reduces the administrative costs from 6% to 5% and applies the extra 1% to the bridge program. Mr. Endicott is soliciting bridge projects from counties in the Cherokee Nation, and due to extra funding, some with sufficiency ratings higher than 30 might be considered.

Contact Mr. Endicott if you have a project that may be eligible for tribal funds.

-Mr. Endicott also reported that they are close to having the entire Cherokee Nation inventory and traffic counts available in a kmz file that can be viewed in Google Earth.

- Division 8
 - Bruce Martin with ODOT Division 8 reported that he received an email from Shannon Sheffert that ODOT has begun issuing ER payments to Counties.
 - e. OCCEDB
 - Mr. Blickensderfer reported that in the past Director Mike Patterson indicated he might allocate additional STP funds to the counties if the State as a whole receives more STP funds which is the case with the recently passed FAST ACT.
 - Mr. Blickensderfer also went over a few handouts from OCCEDB. One of those included an HMA Construction Inspection Training Class, January 21, 2016, in Clinton, OK that has 50 spots available.
 - f. ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative
 - Mike Dunlap gave a SIG-SIF update. SIG and SIF are financially solid. Also, ACCO recently renegotiated lower administrative fees from 3% to 1.5%, which is a savings to the group. Mr. Dunlap also wanted everyone to remember that Local Government University is still available for all sorts of on-line training for everyone from Sheriff's department employees to Courthouse workers.
 - The legislative committee is watching a couple of bills regarding term limits for County Commissioners, and is also working on ways to protect the CIRB money due to the projected budget shortfall.
 - g. County Advisory Board (CAB)
 - Tom Sanders announced that everyone who received an equipment revolving fund loan should have been notified by this meeting. Also, there was a lengthy discussion by the CAB board as to whether the equipment loan money could be used to purchase used equipment. The written requirement says that it can be, but it has been board policy to only allow the purchase of new equipment. The board vote resulted in a tie, so a special meeting will be held to discuss the matter again and then vote again. Those who voted "No" were concerned that commissioners might purchasing used equipment without thoroughly investigating the condition and value; then if there are troubles with the piece of equipment, it might end up being the responsibility of the board.
11. Discussion and possible action to approve projects and funding on the following programs:
- a. Emergency Transportation Revolving (ETR) Fund
 - Mr. Blickensderfer reported that Creek County paid back \$400,000 to the ETR fund. From that money, CED #1 paid back the \$12,000 borrowed from CED #7 and the \$200,000 loan from CED #5. This leaves CED #1 with an available balance of \$188,418.53.
 - b. Surface Transportation Program (STP)
 - i. STP Results
 - Mr. Blickensderfer reported that no projects in CED #1 were approved for the 2020 STP funding program.
 - c. Material Request Program (MRP)
 - Mr. Blickensderfer reported that no new requests have been received. Also, since no money was received from OCCEDB this month, no prior requests can be funded.
 - d. Used Beam Program
 - Mr. Blickensderfer reported that 258 used beams are still available for projects. Tom Rains reported that some Highway 169 beams will be available from his yard as well, but they do not have sheer connectors on them.
 - e. Combined STP(BR) and CIRB Plan
 - Mr. Blickensderfer presented the same plan as in November. He is currently working on updating the spreadsheet with the new ODOT 5 year plan information.
