

WHAT YOUR COUNTY DOES FOR YOU...

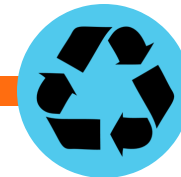
Infrastructure

- Short- and long-range transportation planning
- Construct, maintain, and repair county roads and bridges
- Construct, maintain, and operate public buildings, fairgrounds, parks, libraries, sports complexes, and community centers
- Purchase and sell county properties
- Provide sewer, water, and drainage systems
- Provide landfills and solid waste disposal programs
- Mow county and Indian cemeteries



Health and Safety

- Provide 911 emergency systems and rural fire departments
- Support the courts system by providing jail and court facilities
- Provide emergency management and disaster response services
- Operate health departments, hospitals, and mental health facilities
- Provide hazardous waste drop-off and recycling centers
- Provide animal control services



General Government Services

- Assess properties and collect taxes for the benefit of citizens
- Advocate for you at the state and federal levels
- Partner with cities, state, Federal, and Tribal entities
- Record public documents and issue licenses
- Register voters and conduct elections
- Provide planning and zoning services
- Set policy and budgets for county offices
- Serve as your representative at boards and meetings
- Provide cremation and burial services for indigents
- Actively participate in civic organizations, training, and leadership programs
- Manage county business responsibly, with accountability and transparency
