9. Reports from the following with discussion:

- a. Congressional Representatives
-No representatives were present.
- b. Tribal Projects / Programs
-Rob Endicott with the Cherokee Nation reported that the Cherokee Nation is still in the process of updating their Transportation Infrastructure Program (TIP). There are nine new projects being considered, three of which are in CED#1.
- c. INCOG
-No representatives were present.
- d. ODOT
-Bruce Martin asked everyone to remember that safety while working is very important. Mr. Martin reported that a driver had a seizure and hit a bucket truck with a worker in the bucket, that had all of the proper signage and cones set up per regulations. The worker was very lucky and only injured his hand.
-John Blickensderfer reported that the following projects are letting in the following months:
 - May- Osage County's Quapaw Creek*
 - June- Pawnee County's STP Project - Airport Road.*
 - July- Craig County's Br 63 Pawpaw Creek, Mayes County's Pryor Creek, and Rogers County's Wiganon Crossing.**Also, there are 4 to 5 projects scheduled for an August or September lettings.*
- e. OCCEDB / ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative
-Russell Earls reported that the OCCEDB meeting was very short.
-Scott Hilton reported that the HB1080 bill has passed the House and Senate, but now is hung up in appropriations and is not a completed deal. Also, the CED Bill, Principal Residence Bill and Trash Fines Increase bill have all been approved and sent to the Governor for signature. The Phone Quotes bill has an amendment and is back in the House.
-Gary Deckard reported that SIG/SIF had send appraisers to 37 County courthouses to see if they were adequately insured. What the appraisers found was that most were significantly underinsured. The SIG/SIF board voted to send appraisers to all of the other County courthouses in the state to give them an accurate insurance value.

-Tom Sanders reported that at the last CAB board meeting Roger Chambers said he had sent CAB information out to each County. He also reported that Shannon Sheffert with ODOT spoke

11. Discussions concerning Functional Classification Changes.
-Mr. Blickensderfer informed the commissioners to expect to receive a Functional Classification map from ODOT with instruction on how to request revisions. The Urban Boundary maps are not completed to date, so if the County has an urban boundary, they might not have received their updated map. He also reminded everyone that they cannot add major or minor collector miles, they can only move them around to create the same number of miles that already exist. Gary Ray Howell is the point of contact at ODOT if anyone has any questions.
12. Discussion on possibly hiring a right-of-way agent for CED#1.
-Mr. Blickensderfer reported that it is possible to hire a right-of-way agent through the ODOT Program Management Agreement that the CED has not yet entered into with ODOT. The CED is in the process of gathering an ODOT standard scope of work for acquisition services so they can review it for any items that might not be required by the Federal Highway Administration. There will be one more committee meeting before the CED meeting in May.
