MEETING MINUTES FOR CIRCUIT ENGINEERING DISTRICT #1 REGULAR BOARD MEETING

10. Reports from the following with discussion:
- a. Congressional Representatives
 - *Debbie Dooley relayed that Congressman Mullin would like to invite Mayes, Craig, Ottawa, and Delaware counties to meet with him on July 31 and Rogers/Nowata counties on August 3 to discuss issues in these areas.*
 - b. Tribal Representatives
 - *Rob Endicott with the Cherokee Nation briefly reviewed projects for the Cherokee Nation. Project NS 441 Rd and 434 Road White Oak are both in Right-of-Way stage. Bridges 56 and 57 have one parcel still in condemnation.*
 - c. COG Representatives
 - *Debbie McGlasson with Grand Gateway RTPPO told us that the RTPPO's Fast Lane (Infra) grant has been posted with the state. She asked if everyone could get their projects on the list because the deadline is November 2, 2017.*
 - *Ms. McGlasson also mentioned that Rogers County's Long-Range Plan has been released and is now posted for review for 30 days on grandgateway.org.*
 - *Ms. McGlasson announced that she will be retiring in February 2018 and handing the reins to her staff at Grand Gateway.*
 - d. ODOT
Local Government
 - *Shannon Sheffert spoke on CIRB funding data sent to CEDs to complete the 5-year plans.*
 - *Bruce Martin gave a short presentation on how to read an ER check stub.*
 - *Randy Robinson mentioned that there is a \$120 million dollar cap on CIRB and that we are also losing over \$1.7 million in interest.*
 - e. OCCEDB
 - *Randy Robinson announced that the McAlester auction will be September 23, 2017. The County Equipment Revolving fund applications are due October 1, 2017. He said that he appreciates all the bridge dedications and thanked Guy Engineering for doing them on their bridges. He provided 3 handouts; first was for deficient bridge history, second was on timber pile repair strategies, and third was on climate change.*
 - f. ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative
 - *Russell Earls announced that ACCO District #1 will select 2 commissioners to be on the legislative committee. He also mentioned ACCO is now tracking about 20 interim studies that affect counties. Commissioner Earls reported that the Oklahoma Supreme Court will rule on August 8, 2017 on the \$250 million cigarette tax and the \$120 million sales tax on vehicles.*
 - g. County Advisory Board (CAB)
 - *Ryan Ball announced that CAB revolving fund equipment applications are due October 1, 2017. He said that 50 counties currently use the fund and how important the fund is to use and that the balance is kept low.*

- Dan DeLozier made a motion to approve the OTA Bridge Analysis as presented; Kevin Whiteside seconded.

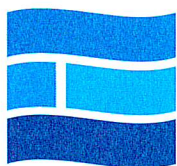
