Local Government
 - *Shannon Sheffert announced that with reduction in CIRB funds, there will be a CED Managers' meeting the morning of Wednesday, January 31st before the OCCEDB meeting. This meeting will discuss the effects on the plan and options moving forward based on limited funds.*
 - e. OCCEDB
 - *Randy Robinson announced that if you're not sure about election year rules pertaining to county funds and expenses to contact him. The Marlow auction made \$34,000.00 and the Elk City Auction is scheduled for March 9th-10th. Mr. Robinson also announced that the current 5-year plan is over programmed by \$130 million, an ACCO legislative meeting is at 2 PM on Wednesday, January 31st and they will go over all the bills. He spoke about the CODA conference and in that conference, there will be workshops with the Sheriffs to help reduce SIG/SIF claims. Randy mentioned that there was about \$35 million in projects let in the last 3 months. Randy discussed 4 or 5 bills introduced in the State House and Senate and said they will be reviewing them at the OCCEDB and ACCO Legislative meetings next week.*
 - f. ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative
 - *Mike Dunlap announced that the driving simulator was going to Washington and Osage Counties in the next few weeks. He also said that the simulator was a great training program. He would like to see the Sheriffs' departments get involved and that there is no cost to the Counties. Rogers and Ottawa Counties have completed the program and were pleased with it.*
 - g. County Advisory Board (CAB)
 - *Shannon Sheffert announced that Betty Freeman (ODOT Local Gov't) was out with knee replacement and she will be back in February part-time. Ryan Ball stated she would get your equipment purchases made upon return. He also mentioned new purchase notices will be out in late February.*

With this loan and payback Delaware County will now receive the ETR funding they requested in the next 30 days for ETRs 59, 60, 61, and 62.*

 - *John Blickensderfer reported that Delaware County D3's STP project will let in February or March of 2018. He also mentioned that the right of way was in hand and that Tulsa County was working on utilities for 86th Street North and Sheridan for the 2019 STP.*
