A. Congressional Representatives

- *No Congressional Report was given.*

B. Tribal Representative

- *Harold LaSarge with Osage Nation gave an update stating that through bipartisan infrastructure law Osage nation has seen an increase in funding. Harold discussed several discretionary grants and said that Osage Nation's bridge funds have increased. Mr. LaSarge briefly spoke on updating Osage Nations road inventory with a GIS system that would be coming soon.*
- *Rob Endicott with Cherokee Nation asked that we talk to Tribal Council members about council funding. Rob said he is keeping an eye on the CIRB list for Cherokee Nation funding. He has a new 2020 KMZ version of the Cherokee Nation Road Inventory and will get it out to CED#1. Rob stated that non-bridge structures that will be replaced with an NBI can also use TTP funds.*

- *Avonlea Barnes with Grand Gateway stated that Jefferson Highway is starting to move and has national designations. There is new funding for scenic byways. Ottawa and Delaware County long-range plans are underway.*

## D. ODOT – Local Government

- *Matt Casillas with ODOT wanted to emphasize that if a County gets used materials from ODOT like millings, used guardrail, or barrier wall it needs to be used at the location listed on the application form. Matt talked how District 8 is looking at addressing structural deficient bridges. One solution could be addressed by fixing scour problems under the bridge. Matt did mention that there may be additional funding to fix these scour problems and get these bridges out of deficiency.*
- *Allison Enright with ODOT talked about ER claims that have a permanent repair needed you must go through the same process as if it had federal funds. It has to have NEPA. Work with ODOT to repair an ER bridge. Allison spoke on funds in 2022 and asked the counties to talk to the CED's before starting a new project.*

## E. OCCEDB

- *Randy Robinson with OCCEDB gave a Kudo to Commissioner Russell Earls for speaking on our behalf at the transportation day at the capital. The Elk City auction was last week and was the third-highest auction in history grossing \$7.5M. Randy stated that the Spring ACCO Conference is next week. Randy mentioned there will be free workshops at the conference covering topics like cyber security, CDL drivers, and federal highway bill. Randy mentioned that ODOT is partnering with us to hire grant writers to seek out federal grants.*

## F. ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative

- *Mike Dunlap gave a report on SIG-SIF stating that they had their first meeting in four months. Financials are good, they settled three claims, and the sheriff's claims are down. Russell Earls added that there is going to be an ACCO board retreat on April 26.*
- *Russell Earls gave the report on ACCO stating they approved five months of financials this last meeting. Approved a hardship for Ottawa County District 1. Russell explained the \$500 application for a hardship that ACCO has. ACCO approved Mike Bouvier for the legislative committee. Russell asked the Commissioners to talk to your state representatives about taking the cap off CIRB funds.*

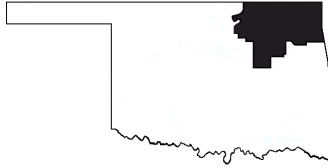

## CIRB PROJECT CRITERIA AND PRIORITY POLICY

To ensure compliance with the Administrative Code for project eligibility and approval the District must establish specific project evaluation criteria and establish a priority for each project. To ensure project are approved and funded based on an established criteria and priority CED#1 hereby institutes the CIRB Project Criteria and Priority Policy.

### Project Approval for Inclusion in the CIRB 5-year Plan

Each member County must provide a list of projects in priority order to the District for consideration of inclusion into the CIRB 5-year Plan. The District will evaluate each project to ensure it meets the minimum criteria to be included in the CIRB 5-year Plan. The evaluation criteria are below:

1. Projects selected and prioritized by the County.
2. The project requires CIRB funding and must be fiscally constrained to meet available CIRB funding, or it will be broken into phases.
3. The project is located on a County road listed in the current road inventory.
4. The project is no more than 7 miles in length.
5. The project is for a roadway or bridge reconstruction or rehabilitation.
6. Bridges should be load posted, structurally deficient, functionally obsolete, or have other outstanding circumstances that will need engineering support for replacement.
7. Project shall meet the scoping requirements as determined by ODOT.

### Project Priority

The District will establish priorities for projects based on the member county's priorities provided to the best of the District's abilities; however, numerous circumstances may arise that require different priorities to be established. The District will prioritize based various factors below:

1. The project has been cleared for letting with all pre-construction activities completed.
2. The emergency need of the project.
3. The insufficient CIRB funds within any specific year.
4. The project is partially funded using federal STP (BR), STP (RD), STP(COG), FEMA, ER, or other federal funds which requires CIRB as matching funds.
5. The project is partially funded with Tribal dollars and requires CIRB as matching funds.
6. The project is a joint project with ODOT, OTA, or other governmental agency and is required to be funded in a specific year.
