She mentioned that they would be awarding 2 years at once for a total of \$44 million. Only the second round will be scored.
- Allison was asked about the small city bridge program. She stated that this is for small cities bridges (2,500 people or less) and it is for new bridges or rehab. No grant applications are out for this program yet.
- Allison was asked about scour bridge program. She said that there are 603 scour bridges across the state. She said there is \$16 million for this program and will address scour only first. The question was asked if there was a list of scour bridges and could we see the list for CED#1 bridges. Allison said that the program manager would be reaching out to the counties.
- Matt Casillas with ODOT gave an update on the used beams in CED#1 stating that a group effort is being made to address the used beams in CED#1. Shelly Williams along with Randy Robinson and ODOT counsel are working on a solution.

E. OCCEDB

• Melinda Anoatubby with OCCEDB wanted to mention that you may see a reduction in distribution on Motor vehicle fee because it has hit its cap. Melinda also stated that the solid waist program from DEQ is now taking applications for the new fiscal year.
