A. Congressional Representatives

- *State Senator Julie Daniels, House District 10 Representative Judd Storm, and House District 11 Representative John Kane thanked the Counties for what they do for our roads and bridges.*

B. Tribal Representative

- *Rob Endicott with Cherokee Nation gave an update on projects in CED#1 that Cherokee Nation is involved with. Br. 72 in Ottawa County has been added to the TIP and moving forward. BR. 119 in Washington County has been added to the TIP and moving forward. BR. 56/57 in Mayes County has been fully funded. Rob said that the Vinita turnpike overpass is moving forward also.*

C. COG Representatives

- *Tami McKeon with Grand Gateway stated that the TAP funding is available now to get your applications in. OWRB will open ARPA funding applications soon. Tami stated that they are securing grant for Tulsa Ports.*

D. ODOT – Local Government

- *Allison Enright with ODOT local government explained that the TAP has started taking applications as of July 1st. After September 30th there will be a secondary final application and the counties could apply for more than one but will need to rank them by importance. She knows of 2 applications so far.*
- *Matt Casillas with ODOT gave an update on ER funds due to May Flooding. Let Matt know if you had damage in your county.*

E. OCCEDB

- *Randy Robison with OCCEDB spoke about county officials' wages and burn bans in the county. Randy spoke about DEQ funding and adding additional options for using the funding and also adding additional funding. A possible use for this funding would be spraying ROW on county roads. They are discussing loosening up the rules when two commissioners are leaving office. Randy said that there will be no auction this year in McAlester.*
- *Randy spoke about HB 2892 – 25% of CIRB to counties monthly up to the cap. Legislation on having a county employee come back within the same year. Randy spoke on federal highway bill grants and getting a list of bridges by December of bridges that they are going to apply for.*
- *Randy mentioned that he can provide a funding presentation for roads and bridges for counties to present at local clubs or constituents. Randy said that the state has 65 new commissioners. That is a record, and 14 incumbents still have a general election.*

F. ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative

- *Dan DeLozier mentioned that ACCO will meet next week.*
- *Mike Dunlap gave a report on SIG-SIF stating that they will meet next week also and there is a permanent hire of a law enforcement officer to help with sheriff's needs. Mike said that they will continue to inventory building within the counties.*

G. County Advisory Board (CAB)

- *Betty Freeman asked the county officials to submit CERF-100 forms for equipment. She said that they are looking to increase allowances for equipment. She told the commissioners to always ask for more than you need. She suggested asking for a motor grader because it the most expensive and then you can reduce it.*

H. NACO report

- *Russell Earls went to the NACO conference in Denver and encouraged all commissioners to go. He said that it was an excellent conference for county officials to attend.*

PROJECT SELECTION PROCESS

CED#1 Materials Request Grant Program

The CED#1 Materials Request Grant Application shall be completed and submitted to the CED for review.

Each request shall be limited to \$50,000; ~~three projects from each county may be submitted.~~ After pictures of the project site shall be submitted to the CED within 6 months of receiving funding.

The projects must meet ODOT Force Account standards.
(i.e. 23 ton load rating and 24 ft clear roadway).

The purpose of this program is to assist counties with the purchase of materials for force account projects. Requests will only be approved for project materials. Labor, equipment, rental equipment, etc., will not be eligible.

The CED#1 Board will first consider the requests in accordance with the following County Classification Designation Order as prepared by CAB, with the “poorest” county ranked #1. Second, they will consider the number of grants each county has received to date. Third consideration will be the immediate need of the project.

If a county submits more than one request, they need to prioritize each request (1+) for the CED.

The Commissioner is responsible to ensure the completed project is in compliance with ODOT Force Account standards (i.e. 23 ton load rating and 24 ft clear roadway). Bridge load ratings will be performed as part of the next scheduled bridge inspection by the county’s selected bridge inspector.

If a project is built that does not meet force account standards, or the County does not provide an ‘after’ picture within 6 months, the county must repay the Materials Request Grant unless granted an exception by the CED board. The county will not be eligible for another Materials Request Grant until they have paid back the funds.
