#### A. Congressional Representatives

• Crystal Campbell with Senator Mullin's office stated that she has business cards if you would like one to come see her. She mentioned that if you need anything from Senator Mullin to contact her.

#### B. Tribal Representative

Rob Endicott with Cherokee Nation gave an update on Tribal
 Transportation new funding could help with new bridges. Rob mentioned
 that the bridge project over the turnpike in Craig County was almost
 complete.

#### C. COG Representatives

• No Report was given.

#### D. ODOT - Local Government

- Jennifer Bullard introduced Josh Fisher the new Claremore Resident Engineer.
- Allison Enright with ODOT stated that they have reshuffled and reassigned projects. She stated that Tulsa, Pawnee, and Washington will go to Ryan. All other counties within CED 1 will go to Allison.
- Allison stated that FHWA approved Ottawa County's ER claim. The Osage ER is still being looked at.
- Ryan Gulliksen with ODOT mentioned BFP, the small city grant will be awarded in April. He also mentioned getting your ER applications in. STP program will be ready by the end of May. Shelly Williams is retiring on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Lastly, he mentioned BIP is just waiting on scope & fees.

#### E. OCCEDB

- Mitch Antle read through his notes stating DEQ program has around \$307,000 left in the account. He motioned that the state's disbursements were up about \$100,000 because of gross production.
- ETR applications were mostly lake access applications.
- CED#8 used Garver for a grant application and received \$11.5 million for 7 bridges.
- Russell Earls mentioned that Randy Robinson talked about an app for vehicles that will track your road conditions.
- Mitch mentioned ETR payback. SA&I will be developing a policy for paying back ETR funds.
- Mitch stated that OCCEDB talked about the authority to accept or deny CED applications for counties.

#### F. ACCO / SIG-SIF / Legislative

 Mike Dunlap went to the SIG-SIF meeting and read through his notes mentioning that the funding and bank account were in excellent condition.

- Mike stated that they are recommending detailed training for deputies.
- Mike mentioned that there were two executive sessions were held. Mike said that they were almost done with the inventory of all county owned structures.
- Dan DeLozier wanted to mention that ACCO voted on a NACO representative, and they voted for Ron Burrows to be the representative.
- Mike Bouvier reported on legislation stating that Senate Bill 951 will increase in truck allowance for county vehicles. He asked to call the Governor's office in support of the bill.
