

The Safety Action Plan will identify projects and strategies to reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries within the Cherokee Nation Reservation roadway network. By gaining leadership commitment, soliciting community and stakeholder input, conducting a comprehensive traffic operational and safety analysis, assessing existing road conditions, and developing prioritized improvement plans and strategies, this project aims to create safer streets for all roadway users.

The "Transit" project will support the Cherokee Nation Department of Transportation in the development of the Long-Range Transportation Plan. It will focus on a plan that is concise, accessible and user friendly. This plan will identify key challenges and opportunities in improving rural transit services, consider emerging technologies and innovative solutions for enhancing interoperability, connectivity, safety & security, improving service efficiency, and reducing environmental impact. The Transit plan will also outline strategies for achieving desired outcomes, addressing identified challenges, and maximizing the effectiveness of transit investments.

The Project Team will work collaboratively to inform stakeholders and the public about each project as it moves forward and to seek valuable input, suggestions and comments. Considering the vast geographic area of the Cherokee Nation, three regions have been identified **- North, South,** and **Urban**. The **North Region** consists of Tulsa, Washington, Nowata, Rogers, Craig, Mayes, Ottawa, and Delaware Counties; The **South Region** consists of Wagoner, Cherokee, Adair, Sequoyah, Muskogee and McIntosh Counties; The **Urban Region** consists of the City of Tulsa.

All stakeholder outreach meetings will be in-person within each designated region. The meetings will emphasize diversity, equity, and adequate representation to create inclusive experiences and build trust to positively impact the future in transportation planning.

The "Transit" plan will define the vision, goals, and objectives, ensuring the alignment with community needs and regional transportation priorities. It will outline strategies for achieving desired outcomes, addressing identified challenges, and maximizing the effectiveness of transit investments. It will consider and identify policy, program and prioritized project solutions with cost estimates.
