#### A. Congressional Representatives

- Crystal Campbell with Senator Mullin's office reported that people from California, New York, and Texas are moving into Oklahoma. More people from Texas are moving into Oklahoma than Oklahoma to Texas. Mrs. Campbell stated that we need to have more infrastructure and housing.
- Crystal stated that if the Counties need support, they will write letters of support for federal monies.

#### B. Tribal Representatives

- Rob Endicott with Cherokee Nation explained that Cherokee Nation will hold public meetings for Safe Streets for All and Transportation. You can find the dates on cnsafetyandtransit.com.
- Rob asked for documentation on the status of Br. 81 Pryor Creek in Craig County and Br. 72 in Ottawa County.

#### C. COG Representatives

Mitch Antle invited all to the RTPO meetings.

#### D. ODOT – Local Government

- Ryan Gullikson with ODOT mentioned that the Equipment Revolving Fund applications are due October 1, 2024.
- Aaron Wallace with ODOT stated that the Comptroller's office is understaffed. Encumbrances are slow. Aaron asked to send copies of URA's to ODOT LG. This will help with timely payment to contractors.

#### E. OCCEDB

- Randy Robinson with OCCEDB stated that on October 24<sup>th</sup> CED#1 meeting he would like to hold a one-hour meeting during our CED meeting.
- Randy explained that there are 41 new County Commissioners. He stated that OCCEDB will have new Commissioner training the first week of December.
