A. Congressional Representatives

- *Crystal Campbell from Senator Mullin's office spoke about the National Defense Authorization Act. She said that they were receiving both good and bad feedback on the tariffs.*
- *Crystal asked for stories from the counties, so she has a good idea of how DC is impacting the counties.*
- *Crystal expressed appreciation for what the counties do for the constituents.*
- *Tamera Bryan, with Senator Brecheen's office, asked us to open an app that gives the national debt. It was at \$38.4T and climbing*
- *State Senator Tom Woods explained that he was headed to a meeting in NE Oklahoma to meet with the poultry producers in the area. He has concerns that Tyson may pull out of Eastern Oklahoma due to lawsuits.*

B. Tribal Representatives

- *Rob Endicott with the Cherokee Nation introduced Melvina Shotpouch, a Tribal Councilwoman who was attending. She expressed gratitude for the partnership with the counties.*
- *Rob mentioned that he needed an invoice for bridge 35 in Delaware County.*
- *Rob said that he submitted bridge 30 in Delaware County for grant funding.*
- *Rob thanked the state Legislature for the PACT funds. He said Counties could Co-Op with the Cherokee Nation but would need to follow federal statute.*

C. ODOT – Local Government
